### **Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants must be a:

- ✓ South Carolina or North Carolina Resident
- ✓ First in Family student defined as a student who will be the first person in their family to attend a 2 or 4 year college
- ✓ Graduating high school senior

### Applicants must submit:

- ✓ An official transcript indicating a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better
- ✓ Admissions acceptance letter. Unfortunately, students applying to online or proprietary schools are not eligible
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation from a high school/college faculty member, school counselor, employer, or church leader
- ✓ One letter of affirmation from a parent/guardian stating the applicant is the first person in his/her family to attend college

### **Award Criteria:**

Scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievements and honors, extracurricular and volunteer participation, work experience and short answer responses.
